Members of the Society who have made distinguished contributions to the discipline may be recognized as Fellows of the LSA. A member who has served as an Officer of the Society will be recognized as a fellow upon completion of service in that office. Any personal member of the LSA will be eligible for election as a Fellow. Nominations may be made by any personal member in good standing. After electing the initial set of Fellows, no more than 10 members will be elected as Fellows each year (not including retired Officers). Further no more than 5% of the total eligible members shall be recognized as Fellows at any time. If Fellows are more than 5% of the total membership, no new Fellows will be elected that year. No member of the Executive Committee will be eligible for election as a Fellow while serving in that office. Members who are Fellows may be nominated to serve on the Executive Committee.
